

**Northern Star Skating Academy Inc. / Stratford SC/ Ice Stage Power Skating  
COVID -19 Policies/Protocols**

1. NSSA/SSC/ISPSS will supply Education Resources on new safety and hygiene protocols to it's membership.
2. NSSA/SSC/ISPSS will implement a Covid-19 Response Plan.
3. Communication of all Covid -19 information will be done through e-mail and posted on our Facebook page and website.
4. Two signed Waiver forms must be signed by each participant prior to participation in any club/school activity. One is Skate Ontario, the other is City of Stratford.
5. All individuals taking part in club/skating school activities must self-screen in accordance with current public health guidelines before each training session.
6. Screening will be done on a daily basis on-site before participation in any club/school activities.
7. The NSSA/SSC/ISPSS will track all skaters, coaches participation in club/school activities on a daily basis. This will be recorded and used for contract tracing.
8. As of September 1, no more than 36 skaters and coaches will be allowed on one session at a time. This will be updated as the government updates their policies.
9. Skaters will use appropriate entrance and exit doors to the facility.
10. Only one parent per child (under 18) is permitted at the facility. Parents that are comfortable leaving the rink are encouraged to do so to keep numbers in the facility low.
11. Participants will wash/sanitize hands upon entry to the facility.
12. Warm-ups and Cool-downs will be done outside of facility and at least 2m apart from others.
13. Skaters must wear a face mask while in facility until on the ice.
14. Coaches must wear a face mask while in the facility until on the ice.
15. Skaters must arrive to the facility in their athletic wear. Dressing rooms will be open to put on skates only.
16. Personal items must be left in vehicle. Each skater must use own water bottle, tissue box, etc.
17. Skaters must remain 2m apart at all times while on the ice.
18. All winter gloves should be washed on a daily basis.
19. Skaters must have closed containers to take home any waste (tissues, etc) from the facility. All waste must be disposed of at home.
20. Coaches will maintain physical distancing from all skaters and coaches of at least 2m.
21. Coaches will be responsible for all injuries on the ice. They will have masks/shields readily available to be able to do close contact. All injuries will be reported immediately to City of Stratford.
