





## Northern Star Skating Academy Inc. / Stratford SC/ Ice Stage Power Skating School COVID -19 Policies/Protocols

- 1. NSSA/SSC/ISPSS will supply Education Resources on new safety and hygiene protocols to it's membership.
- 2. NSSA/SSC/ISPSS will implement a Covid-19 Response Plan.
- 3. Communication of all Covid -19 information will be done through e-mail and posted on our Facebook page and website.
- 4. One signed Waiver form must be signed by each participant prior to participation in any club/school activity. This is for Skate Ontario.
- 5. All individuals taking part in club/skating school activities must self-screen in accordance with current public health guidelines before each training session.
- 6. Screening will be done on a daily basis on-site before participation in any club/school activities.
- 7. The NSSA/SSC/ISPSS will track all skaters, coaches participation in club/school activities on a daily basis. This will be recorded and used for contract tracing.
- 8. Only Parents/Guardians/Siblings of skaters are permitted at the facility. Parents that are comfortable leaving the rink are encouraged to do so to keep numbers in the facility low.
- 9. Participants will wash/sanitize hands upon entry to the facility.
- 10. Warm-ups and Cool-downs will be done outside of facility and at least 2m apart from others.
- 11. Skaters must wear a face mask while in facility until on the ice.
- 12. Coaches mush wear a face mask while in the facility until on the ice.
- 13. Skaters must arrive to the facility in their athletic wear. Dressing rooms will be open to put on skates only.
- 14. Personal items must be left in vehicle. Each skater must use own water bottle, tissue box, etc.
- 15. All winter gloves should be washed on a daily basis.
- 16. Skaters must have closed containers to take home any waste (tissues, etc) from the facility. All waste must be disposed of at home.
- 17. Coaches will be responsible for all injuries on the ice. They will have masks/shields readily available to be able to do close contact. All injuries will be reported immediately to City of Stratford.
